Re: PHASE I & PHASE II SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL CERTIFICATION WEBINARS

Online training sessions for the above captioned certification programs will be held soon. The courses will <u>ONLY</u> be open to sanitarians, local health officials and other municipal officials currently employed with a local health department and/or municipality in the capacity of regulating subsurface sewage disposal systems. Attendance and successful completion of the examination is required for all regulatory officials pursuant to Public Health Code Section 19-13-B103e (b) (2). Attendance for previously certified individuals is not required; however, such individuals may attend.

Training sessions are from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM and will be held via a webinar. Pre-registration for the certification programs is required. Registration will be through TRAIN at <u>https://ct.train.org</u>. Existing TRAIN members can login to TRAIN using their current username and password. New users will need to create a new member profile. After login, the certification courses will be listed in the upcoming events.
